

The Board of Commissioners met in the Surveyors office at 8:00 A.M. to transact the days business. The meeting was called to order by the President, Glen Dunn, with all members present.

The first order of business was to sign all claims that was advertised and entered in the Commissioners docket.

A motion by Byers and seconded by Threlkeld to fix the charge for care and Maintenance of persons in the County Home. The charge is \$ 43.00 per month, or for lesser periods \$10.00 per week per person, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 270, Acts of 1951. Carried unanimously.

A petition was put in by a group from White River Township to have a road near Honey Creek Church black topped. The petition was filed in the Auditor's office for future reference.

Mr. Todd appeared before the Board to discuss the dog situation in the County. The board heard the complaints and then decided by consent to continue as they have in the past.

Motion by Threlkeld to appoint Dudley Harmon to finish the unexpired term of Len Hensley on the appeal Board. Seconded by Byers. Motion Carried.

The 4-H Executive Fair Board Committee appeared before the Board to discuss a tax levy for the construction and maintenance for the fair grounds. No definite decision has been made.

The Board then took up the question of "The Town of New Whiteland." The Court Decree was read to them and explained. It is as follows.-

Come now the parties, namely: the petitioners for the incorporation of the town designated in these proceedings as plaintiffs, petitioners and appellants, in person and by their attorney, Elmon M. Williams; and this cause having heretofore been taken under advisement, the Court, after having heard evidence and being fully and sufficiently advised in the premises, now finds that Robert K. Dunn et al, qualified voters and real estate owners residing and owning real estate within the following described real estate, situate within the County of Johnson, State of Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Southwest Quarter and a part of the Northwest Quarter and a part of the Northeast Quarter and a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 21, Township 13 north, Range 4 East of the 2nd Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of said section and running north 88 degrees and 33 minutes and 0 seconds east on and along the south line of said section 1774.98 feet; thence north 0 degrees and 0 minutes and 53 seconds west 1578.11 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot No. 39 in Maple Crest 3rd Subdivision, 2nd Section, near Whiteland, Indiana; thence east on and along the south side of said Lot 39 a distance of 150 feet to the southeast corner of said Lot 39; thence north on and along the east side of said Lot 39 a distance of 75 feet to the northeast corner of said Lot 39; thence west on and along the north side of said Lot 39 a distance of 150 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot 39; thence north 75 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot No. 41 in said subdivision; thence east on and along the south side of said Lot 41 a distance of

S. Road No. 31; thence north 16 degrees and 38 minutes and 57 seconds west 1588.38 feet; thence south 88 degrees and 22 minutes and 38 seconds west 3005.92 feet to the west line of said section; thence south on and along the said west line of said section 4031.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 238.72 acres;

petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Johnson County, Indiana that said territory be incorporated as a town by the name of "The Town of West Whiteland, " under the laws of this State; that since the filing of said petition it has been amended by the order of this Court so that the name of the proposed incorporated town should be "The Town of New Whiteland, Indiana". The Court further finds that said petition has been signed by at least one-third of the whole number of the qualified voters of said territory, and also by one-third of the whole number of real estate owners residing within said territory and owning real estate therein, and that there was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Johnson County, Indiana, an accurate survey and map, the accuracy of which has been duly verified, and which said survey and map were left at a public and convenient place, to-wit: 101 Westbrook Drive, within said territory, subject to the examination by any person desiring to examine them for a period of not less than twenty (20) days before the first day of the term of said Board at which said petition was presented; and that a census of the resident population of said territory was taken, showing that there were residing therein on the 12th day of March, 1954, four heads of families having a population of sixteen (16), of which six (6) were qualified voters.

The Court further finds that due notice of the intention to present said petition was given by the petitioners for twenty (20) days by posting written notices thereof in at least three (3) of the most public places within said territory; that said petitioners complied with all of the provisions of the law incumbent upon them to be performed in the incorporation of said territory prior to presenting the same to the Board of Commissioners of Johnson County,

Indiana; and that said Board of Commissioners, by its order and judgment, rejected and denied the prayer of said petition, from which order and judgment said petitioners appealed to this Court.

The Court further finds that the Board of County Commissioners of Johnson County, Indiana, was in error in rejecting and denying the application of said petitioners; that said territory should be incorporated as a town to be known as "The Town of New Whiteland, Indiana" if the qualified voters thereof assent thereto; that an election should be held at a convenient place within said territory, on a day to be fixed by the Board of Commissioners of Johnson County, Indiana, of the qualified voters of said territory, for the purpose of determining whether or not said territory shall be incorporated as town, notice of which election should be given by the County Auditor by ten days' publication in the Franklin Evening Star, in Johnson County, Indiana, and the Johnson County News.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the judgment and order of the Board of Commissioners of Johnson County, Indiana, rejecting and denying the application of petitioners for the incorporation of the area described in said application as a town, be and the same is hereby reversed, and this cause is remanded to said Board with directions to said Honorable Board forthwith to enter an order ordering that said territory be incorporated as a town to be known as "The Town of New Whiteland, Indiana" if the qualified voter thereof assent thereto; that an election be held at some convenient place within said territory, on a day and at a time to be designated by said Board of Commissioners, such time to be not more than 20 days from the due receipt by said Board of this decree, said election to be held for the purpose of determining whether or not said territory shall be incorporated as a town, notice of which election shall be given by the County Auditor by ten days' publication in the Franklin Evening Star of Johnson County, and the Johnson County News.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECREED that the further proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners with regards to said cause of action, and all orders made pertaining thereto, shall be had in conformity to law, and the Clerk of this Court is hereby directed to certify a copy of this decree forthwith to the Auditor of Johnson County, Indiana, and to enter in the records of this action that such certification has been made.

Central Standard Time on the 20th day of July, 1954, pursuant to the notice of the Auditor of Johnson County, Indiana as published.
